Dear Resident,

This is just a friendly reminder from the Village of Addison's Department of Forestry to water your newly planted parkway tree(s).

The Village of Addison has placed an irrigation bag around the trunk of your parkway tree and filled it initially with water. The irrigation bag will allow the water to slowly drain and saturate the root ball over a period of 6 hours. Watering your tree everyday is not good. As we experience dry weather, a thorough deep soaking once every 7 days is necessary for your trees health and survival. If you notice dry or cracking soil around your tree, additional watering may be necessary. Just fill the bag by inserting a garden hose in the opening under the label-flap. The village will remove the irrigation bag in the fall to re-use on other trees planted throughout Addison during the following year.
